EDUCATION

This program targets community transformation through free and low-cost programs for immigrant and underserved individuals. English and citizenship test preparedness classes are offered year-round, and seasonal initiatives like "We've Got Your Back" help families at our partner schools.

OPENING DOORS: Meet Saori

Saori and her husband relocated to the U.S. from Japan after his job moved them overseas. Today, Saori works as a CPA at a large firm in the U.S., a role which will be transferable when she moves back to Japan.



This program brings targeted, preventative care and education to the community, focusing on nutrition, access to fresh food, and health literacy. The Local Good Market and Local Good Kitchen provide students with hands-on learning and nutritious supplementation.



RESTORING WELLNESS: Meet Jane

Jane* started her journey at Local Good Center through the ESL Program and quickly became an active participant, utilizing all of our wrap-around services and building relationships with staff and volunteers. When she started experiencing tooth pain, she was desperate for care but couldn't afford it. After connecting with the LGC's Wellness team, Jane was referred to a community clinic (an LGC partner) where she was able to receive free dental treatment.


