- If nothing changed about your current home or parenting, what do you think your child's primary memories would be?

## Now, read Proverbs 24:3-4, Hebrews 3:4, and Matthew 7:24-27.

- Proverbs talks about building with wisdom and knowledge. What is one way this series has inspired you to gain more wisdom and knowledge about a specific skill or area of parenting?
- Ryan shared how building a culture of seeking godly wisdom in our homes involves stillness, hearing God's Word, and practicing God's Word. Of
  those three things, which area do you think you need to focus on? Why?
- Many of us feel exhausted as we try to raise and empower the next generation. Do you feel that way today? What do you think causes us to feel overwhelmed when it comes to parents and kids?
- Can you think of a time where you felt really overwhelmed in your home life and then God showed up in a big way? Share with the group.
- If you were to describe the goal of parenting in one sentence, what would it be?
