- Read Psalm 103:8-13. How does God parent us? What are some principles we can take in how we parent or influence the next generation?
- What do you think you uniquely bring to the table when it comes to building up the kids in your life?
- Tim talked about how we all need to have deliberate determination in how we parent. What are some words or actions you have to be incredibly intentional about saying or doing in order to be the kind of parent you want to be?
- · When it comes to raising kids, it's easy to feel guilt, shame, or unqualified. Are you feeling any of these feelings right now? Share with the group.
- What does it mean to be a grace-based parent? How can you grow in grace as you seek to influence the kids in your life?
