STEP 2: GET SPECIFIC ABOUT NEXT STEPS

A group at Chase Oaks is a small gathering of **friends** committed to taking **next steps** in their relationship with Jesus together each season. This means your role as the leader is **to help friendships deepen** and **encourage everyone to take next steps** in faith. That all sounds nice, but what does it actually look like to take next steps? A disciple is a Christ-follower who is maturing in **faith, hope,** and **love.** To break that down into a few examples, look at the list below.

FAITH

- Starting a relationship with Jesus
- Trusting Jesus more and more that He is who He said He is and will do what He said He would do
- Getting baptized
- Doing Established
- Learning how to share the Gospel
- Engaging more with the Bible (the story overall, a particular book, or techniques on how to interact with it on a daily basis)
- Learning more about God (theology)
- Processing tricky questions and doubts

HOPE

- Navigating current events and cultural issues with grace and truth
- Discovering my strengths and gifts, and using them to further God's mission
- Not putting hope in money and financial gain; growing in generosity
- Serving on a team at Chase Oaks Church that makes a difference
- Better understanding racial injustice and embracing my role to help in reconciliation
- Processing shame, guilt, addictive behavior through the hope of Jesus
- Finding hope in the midst of chaos

LOVE

- Loving God through spending more time with Him (prayer, reading Scripture, silence)
- Improving my relationship with my spouse or significant other
- Improving my relationship with my kids or family members
- Becoming a better communicator and listener in all my relationships
- Developing more authentic friendships
- Loving others through difficult circumstances
